Course Overview:

This course will address the California State Standards for Geometry. Geometry is for the 8th grade student who has passed Algebra 1 with a C or better. A listing of the California Mathematics Standards for Geometry can be found on the mathematics department website. If you believe your student has been placed in the wrong course, contact the teacher immediately. The textbook for the course is Geometry published by McDougal Littell.

Grading and Academic Expectations:

Assignments may include warm ups, class work, homework, notes, special problems and other items that are relevant to the material being taught. Quizzes will be given periodically without notice. Advance notice will be given for tests. All work must be completed in pencil. More information on work policies and procedures will be found in the Parent Letter. The final exams will be comprehensive in nature. Classroom rules and teacher expectations will be provided by your assigned teacher.
