

My general expectation is that your student comes to class with a positive attitude, prepared to participate in all components of class. Your student will be graded on daily participation, written assignments, and work outs of the day. Students will need a composition notebook for my class by _____. A student who is absent is responsible for coming to make-ups held on Thursdays. Students should report to the blacktop during the first 5 minutes of lunch for the participation and aerobic fitness make up assignment.

You should expect your student to have written assignments throughout the year. It is my expectation that all assignments be completed with thoughtful responses. Most assignments will be completed in class and kept in an interactive notebook. Some assignments will be completed for homework. Students can turn in written assignments 1 day late for half credit. If your student is absent, he/she is responsible for obtaining missed assignments. After obtaining the assignments, your student will be given adequate time to make up and complete assignments missed while absent.
