## Course Overview:

This course will address the Common Core State Standards for 7<sup>th</sup> grade. Math 7A/7B (Support) is for 7<sup>th</sup> grade students who are below or close to meeting the 7<sup>th</sup> grade standards. The textbook for this course is “Go Math, Middle School, Grade 7”, published by Houghton Mifflin Harcourt.
