Course Overview:

This course will address the California State Standards for Mathematics I. Math I is for 8th grade students who have successfully completed the Math 7 Accelerated Course. The textbook for Math I is "California Integrated Mathematics I" published by Houghton Mifflin Harcourt.

Grading and Academic Expectations:

Assignments may be on the chromebook or on paper. It is required that students **bring their charged chromebook and cord daily**. Assignments may include warm ups, class work, homework, notes, special problems and other items that are relevant to the material being taught. Tests and quizzes will be given periodically. Final exams, if given, will be comprehensive in nature. Your assigned teacher will provide classroom rules and teacher expectations.
