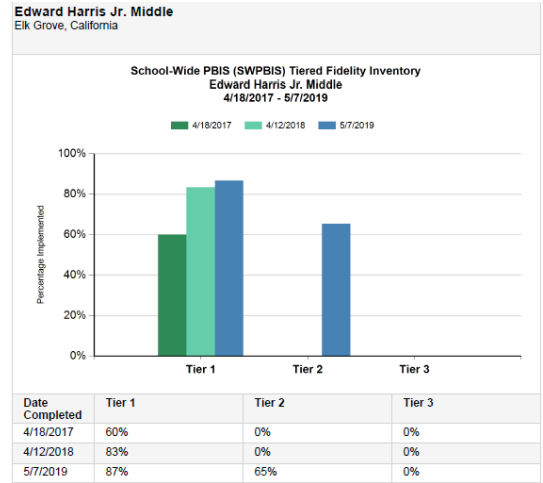

How are we implementing PBIS at our school in Tier 1?

The Tiered Fidelity Inventory (our PBIS assessment) indicates that we were implementing Tier I with fidelity at 83% in 2017-18 school year. Within the core features, we were above benchmark in Implementation and Evaluation. In our action plan, we have focused on items to improve our Team structure by recruiting a parent team member. For 2018-2019 we are implementing Tier 1 with fidelity at 87%.



What is our Suspension Rate?

Our 2017-2018 suspension rate of 8.1 *(number of suspensions per 100 students)* WAS above the district average. Our 2018-2019 school average is 2.5 as a result of teaching school wide expectations during our 2-day Kickoff, implementing follow up lessons in advocacy, and strengthening our RICH ticket rewards system. Our new Restorative Practices room also helps with consistent reflections, consequences, and restoration of students back to the learning environment.
